

## Using Command Targets



The Command Target box in the mixer is located in the upper left of the standard mixer view.



There are many commands in Cubase, but for this example we will use the narrow/wide channel command. This command is located directly above the Target Command box. It looks like this:



The arrow pointing right will expand tracks and the arrow pointing left will narrow the tracks. By default this command effects all channels in the mixer. Using the Command Target we can determine if the effected channels will exclude input channels, exclude output channels, or only effect selected tracks. For this example we will use “Exclude Output Channels”. This is the third button of three as shown below.



Now if we select the “All Targets Narrow” button



(Right arrow)

All the tracks excluding the output channels on the right will be narrowed as shown below.
