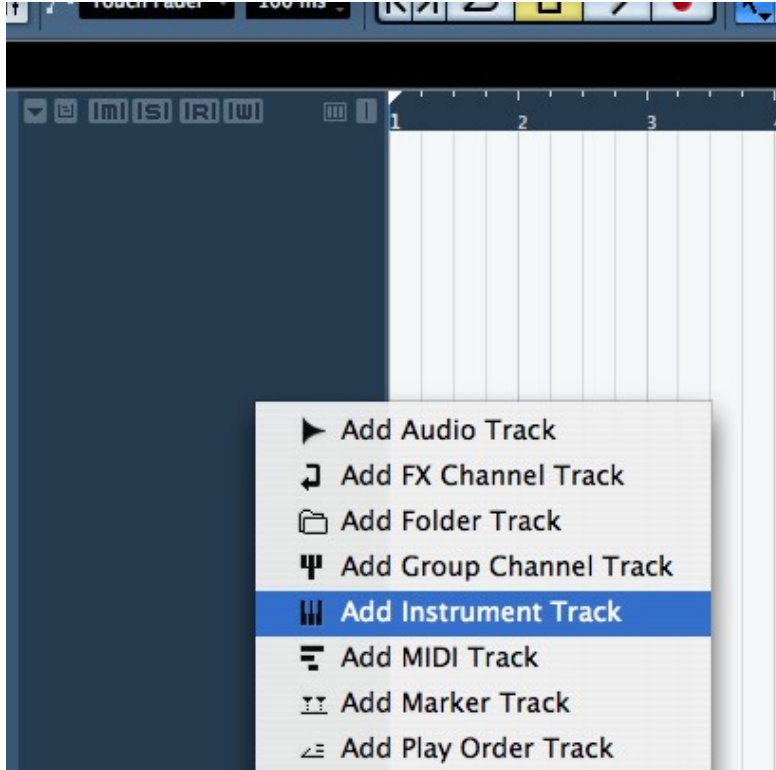
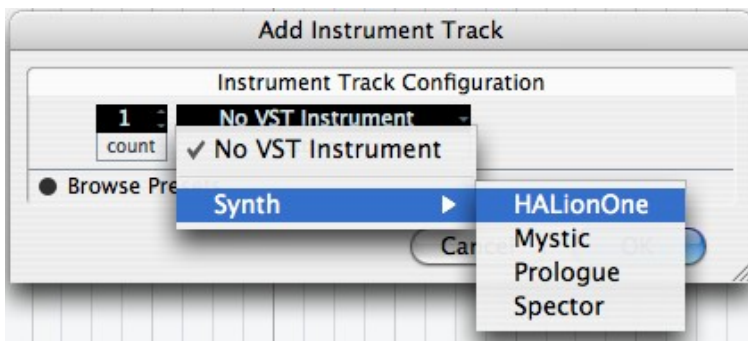


Using Instrument Tracks in Cubase

First right click in the track lane and choose Add Instrument Track. You can also add instrument tracks by going to the Project pull down menu and choose Add track then select Instrument Track.



Next you can select how many tracks to create and what instrument plug-in to open with the instrument track.



Now you will have an instrument track for the plug-in you've selected. The behavior of the instrument track is almost identical to a midi track. The main difference is with a midi track you assign the output to an instrument in the VST instruments panel/rack. With an instrument track when you assign the output to a new instrument it closes and opens a new instrument just for use with that track. For example if you have an instrument track set out to HalionOne, when you change the output from HalionOne to Mystic, it closes HalionOne and opens Mystic for use with the instrument track.
