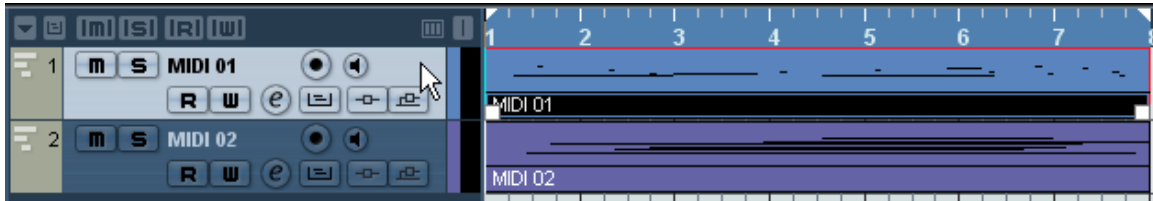


Cubase 4 – Using the Key editor in the Project Window

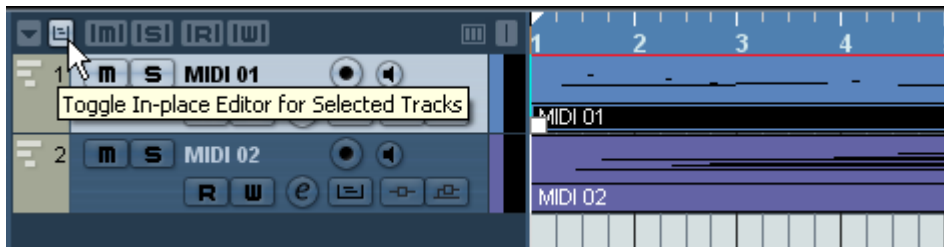
In Cubase 4, there is a new way to instantly have access to the key editor inside the project window without opening a separate key editor window.

Follow these steps:

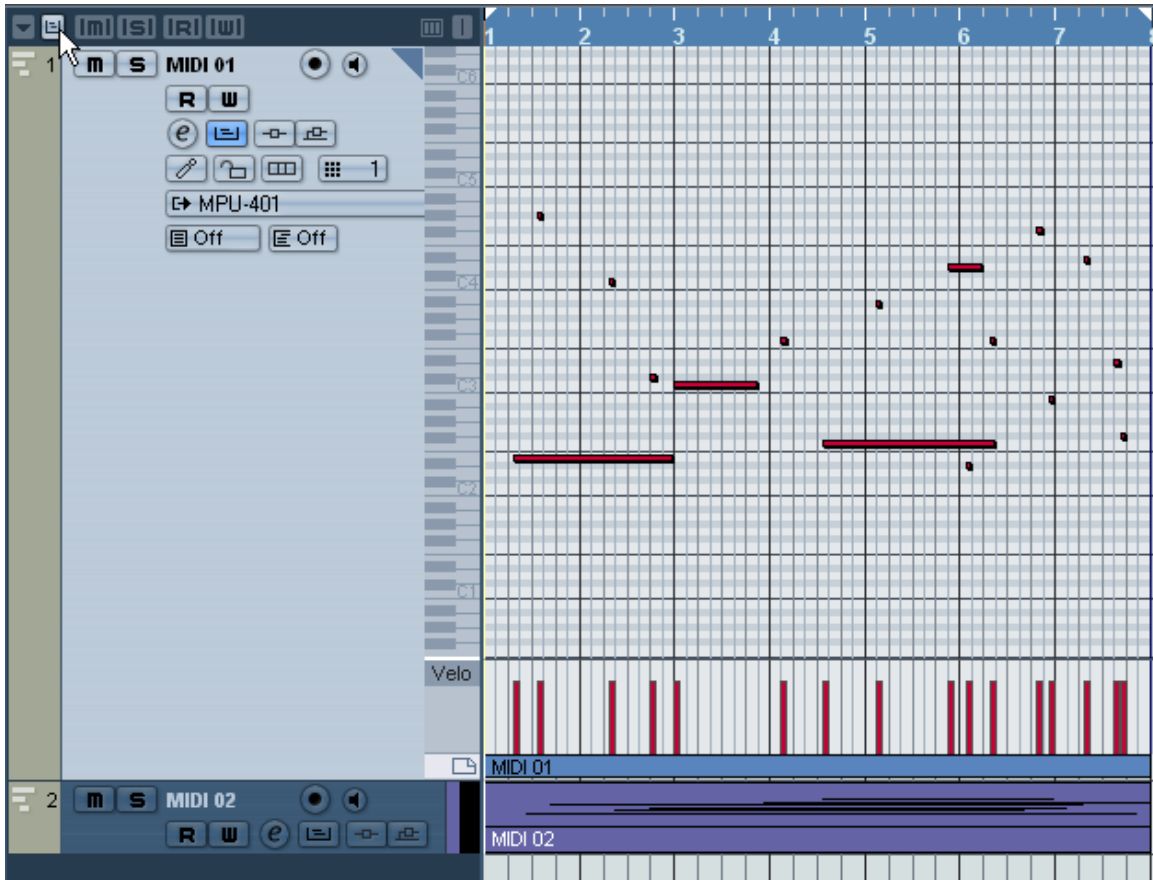
1. Select the midi track that you want to edit.



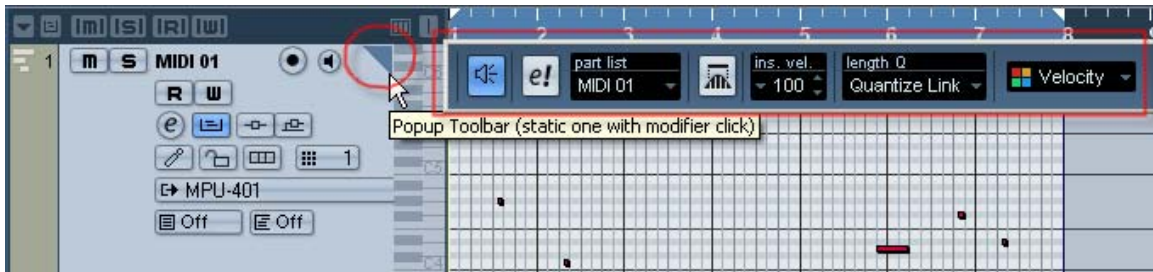
2. Select the button named “Toggle In-place Editor for Selected Tracks” at the top of the track column.



3. You will now see the key editor for the selected MIDI track in the project window!



4. To access specific functions that are available in the key editor window, select the Popup Tool bar triangle at the upper right corner of the Key Editor in the track column.



5. Whenever you are finished, you can select the "Toggle In-place Editor" button again to close the key editor in the project window.
