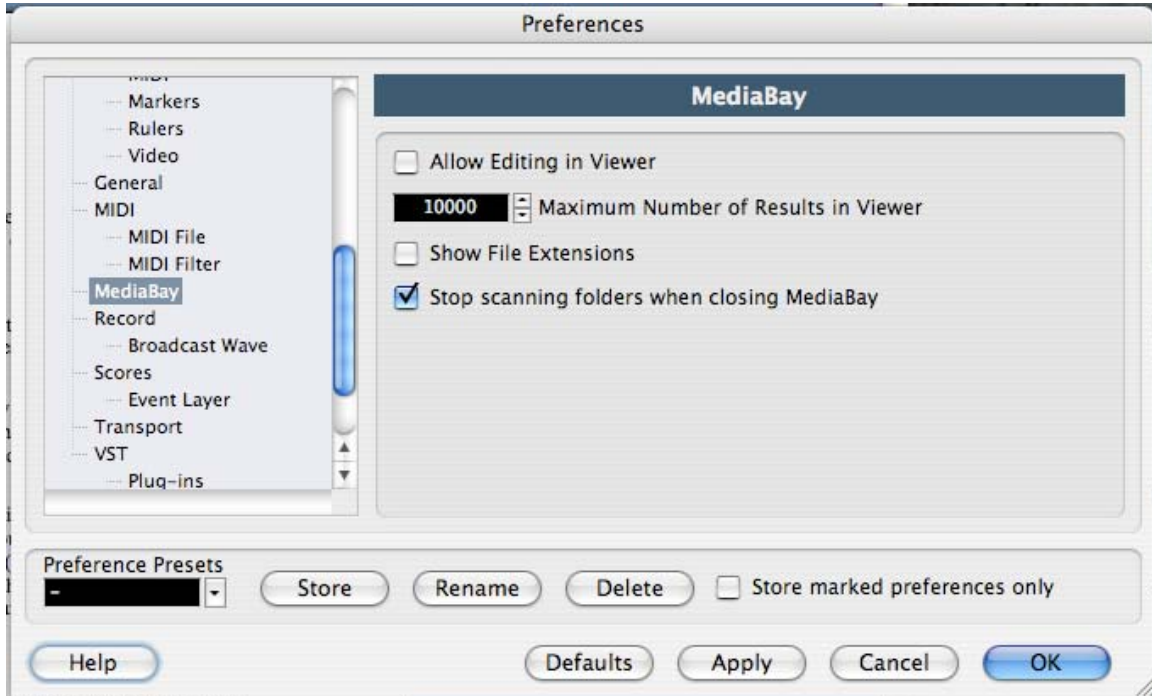


MediaBay Preferences



Allow Editing in Viewer

When this is activated, you can edit file properties also in the Viewer area of the MediaBay window. When this option is deactivated, editing can only be done in the Tag Editor.

Maximum number of results in Viewer

Use this parameter to specify the maximum number of files that should be displayed in the Viewer. Use this to avoid unmanageably long lists of files in the Viewer.

Stop scanning folders when closing MediaBay

When this is activated, the scanning for media files will only be done when the MediaBay window is open. Although MediaBay scanning is designed not to interrupt your work in the editors and scanning will be paused in play or record mode, this feature gives you full control over the scanning process.

When this option is deactivated, the folders will be scanned in the background, even when the MediaBay window is not open. This is useful if you have a large number of files on your hard disk(s), as it allows you to do other work (in another window, e.g. the Project window or an editor) while your hard disks are searched for media files. You can return to the MediaBay window, when all (or the allowed number, see above) media files are displayed in the Viewer.

Show File Extensions

Activate this when you want files to be shown with their file extensions (e.g. .wav, .mp3, etc.) in the MediaBay. When this option is deactivated, the files are displayed without file extensions.
