

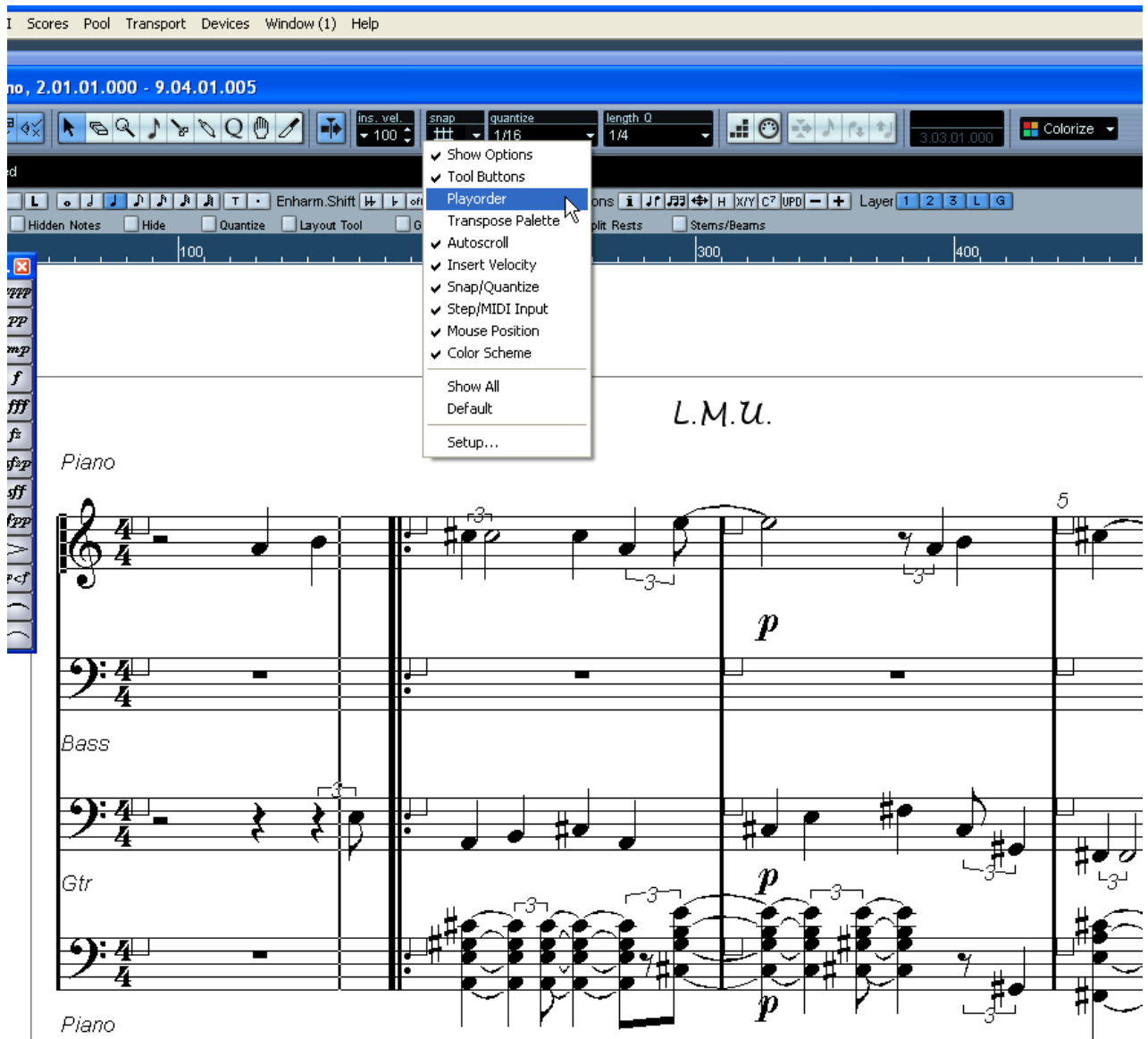
# Using Score Play Order to Follow Musical Symbols

Q: How do I get Cubase to pay attention to my repeats, D.C. al Coda's, etc?

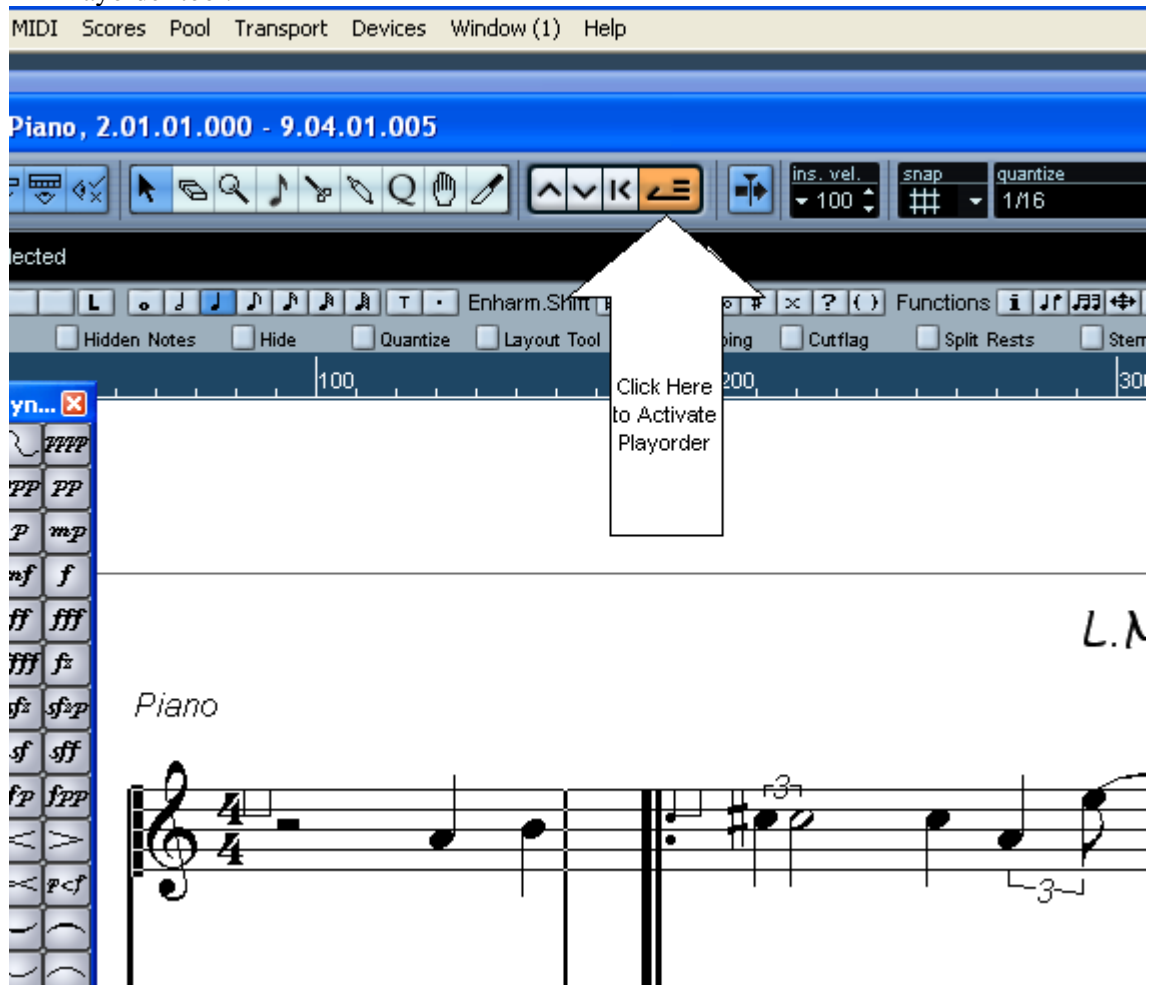
A: Use the Score Play Order Function.

In the score window, Cubase can use Score playorder to follow the music symbols in playback.

1. Open the Score Editor (ctrl r). In the top tool bar, right click to see a pull down menu of options. Check Playorder, to add the Playorder to the toolbar.



2. Activate the Playorder function by clicking on the button to the farthest right of the Playorder tool.



Now Score will follow your musical repeats.

NOTE: This Playorder will only function when the Score window is open. Cubase will playback as normal if the Score window is not selected.

TIP

To set a repeat, double-click on a bar line and change the bar to a repeat double-bar.
