

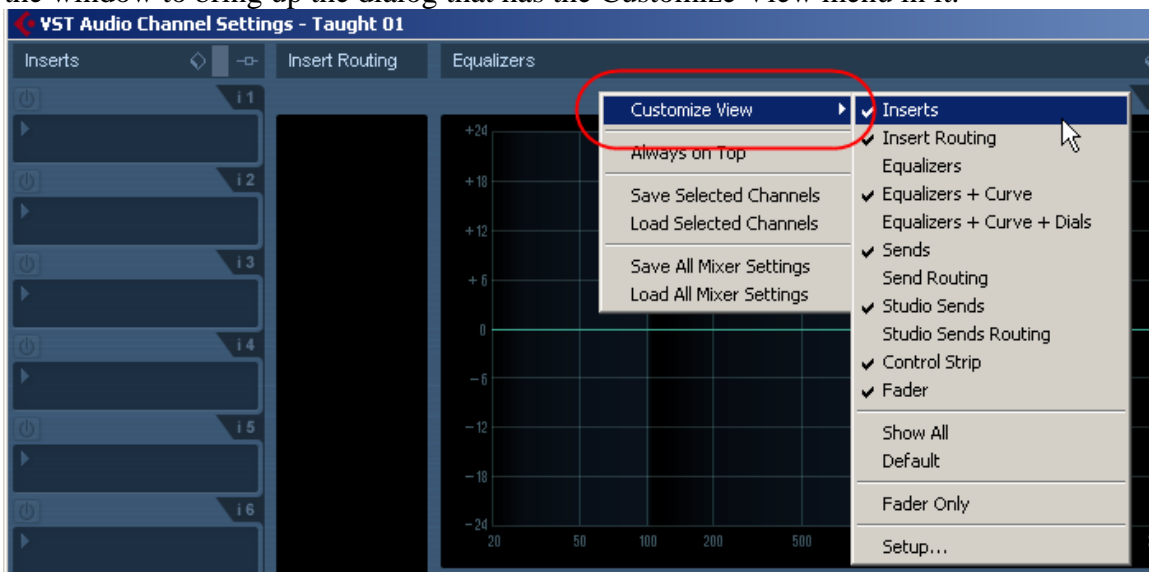
Cubase 4 - User Configurable Channel Settings Window

Cubase 4 allows the Channel Settings window for any audio and midi tracks to be custom-configured. Sections can be switched on or off, and their left-to-right order can be changed as well. Configurations can be saved as view presets.

1. The first thing to do is open the Channel Settings window for an audio or midi track. For this example an audio track is used. To open the Channel Settings window, click on the Edit button of the track.



2. Once the Channel Settings window is opened you can right-click on an empty area in the window to bring up the dialog that has the Customize View menu in it.



3. You'll notice all of the items that can be visible in the Channel Settings window. Any item that has a check beside it will be visible. To adjust the left-to-right placement of these items in the Channel Settings window you can click on Setup...

4. In the Setup window the visible items are listed in the left window and the non-visible items are listed in the right window. Selecting a visible item and clicking on the Move Up button will shift it to the left in placement within the Channel Settings window. Once the settings have been made they can be saved as Presets for later recall.
