

Halion Symphonic Orchestra Content

When installing the Halion Symphonic Orchestra there is the 24-Bit content and the 16-Bit content. Installing both formats can take up a fairly large amount of hard drive space within your computer. If you have no intentions of using both formats, you can install only the 16-Bit or only the 24-Bit. This will save you space on your hard drive.

1. Place the disk into your DVD drive that is labeled *Installer/ Content 1* and follow through with the setup.
2. After the setup is complete you may choose to install the 24-Bit or 16-Bit or both. If you decided to go with both formats or the 24-Bit format you can move on to the disk that is labeled *Content 2 (24-Bit)*.
3. If you choose to install only the 16-Bit format you may go ahead and place the 4th disk in the drive labeled *Content 4 (16-Bit)*
4. When installing either format you will find the content installer located on the disk. If your computer is configured to Auto-play a window should open up showing you the contents of the disk once you place it in your drive. Double-click on the Installer to continue with the installation of the content.
