

Nuendo - Importing Premiere Generic EDL files

You can transfer audio files and their associated edits from the Adobe Premiere application to Nuendo. This is made possible by rendering a “Generic EDL” file from a session in Premiere, and importing the resulting file.

Proceed as follows:

1. Select “Premiere Generic EDL...” from the Import submenu on the File menu.
2. Navigate to the location of the Premiere Generic EDL file, select it and click Open. You are now prompted to select a name and location for the new project folder that will be created.
3. After selecting, the new project opens containing all the audio files stored in the Premiere Generic EDL file and their associated edits. Nuendo will also automatically extract any audio from video files if the audio is referenced in the EDL file.
