

AFL and PFL Functions in Nuendo

Q: What is AFL? PFL? How can I use them in Nuendo?

A: Using the Listen Function in Nuendo.

For this example the Control Room must be enabled. If you have not used the Control Room Function yet, please be sure to read the Nuendo 3.2 manual addendum. Available at

AFL – After Fader Listen. In this mode, the Listen button will send the signal of the track after the fader (meaning that the signal includes the inserts, EQ's, fader volume changes etc) to the Listen bus.

PFL – Pre Fader Listen. In this mode, the Listen button will send the signal of the track before the fader (meaning before inserts EQ's, fader volume changes etc) to the Listen bus.

You can select whether the Listen function will be AFL or PFL in the control room mixer.





Be sure that the Control Room monitor that you are listening to has LE (listen enable) turned on and then you will be able to use the Listen control without affecting the other output channels.
