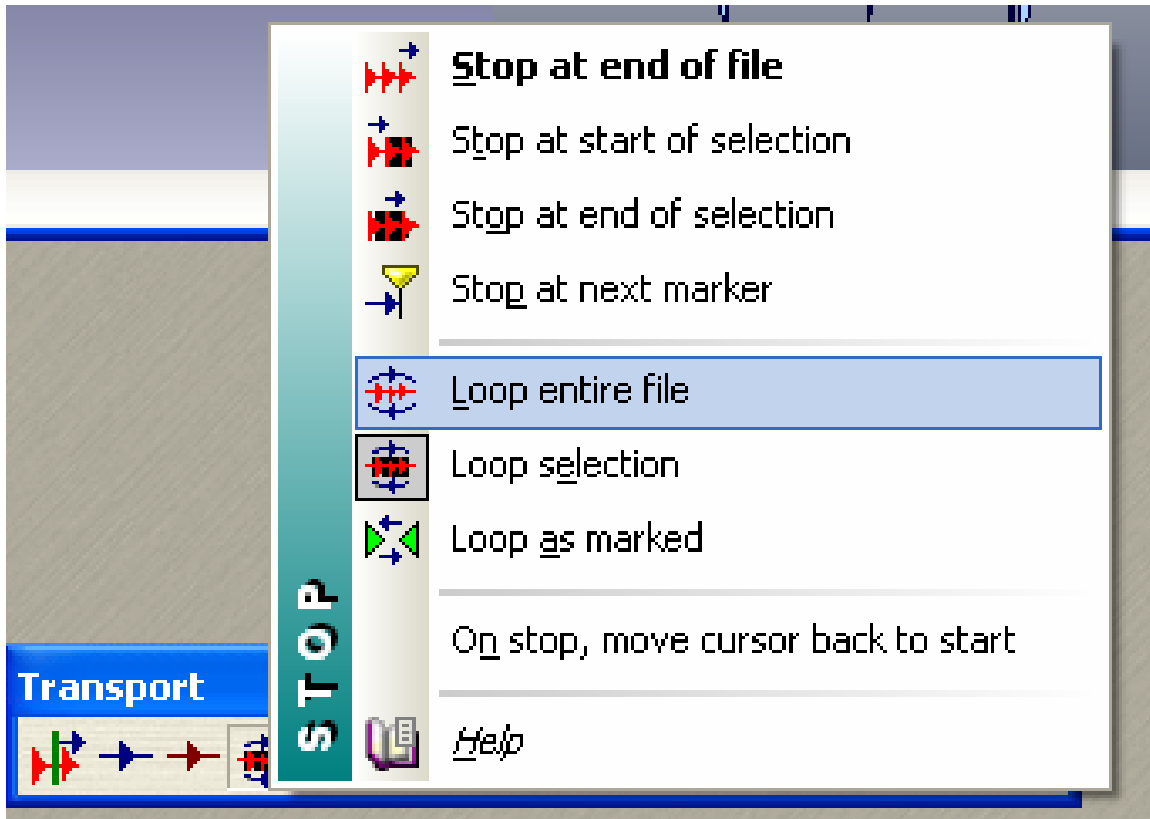


Creating a Loop in Wavelab

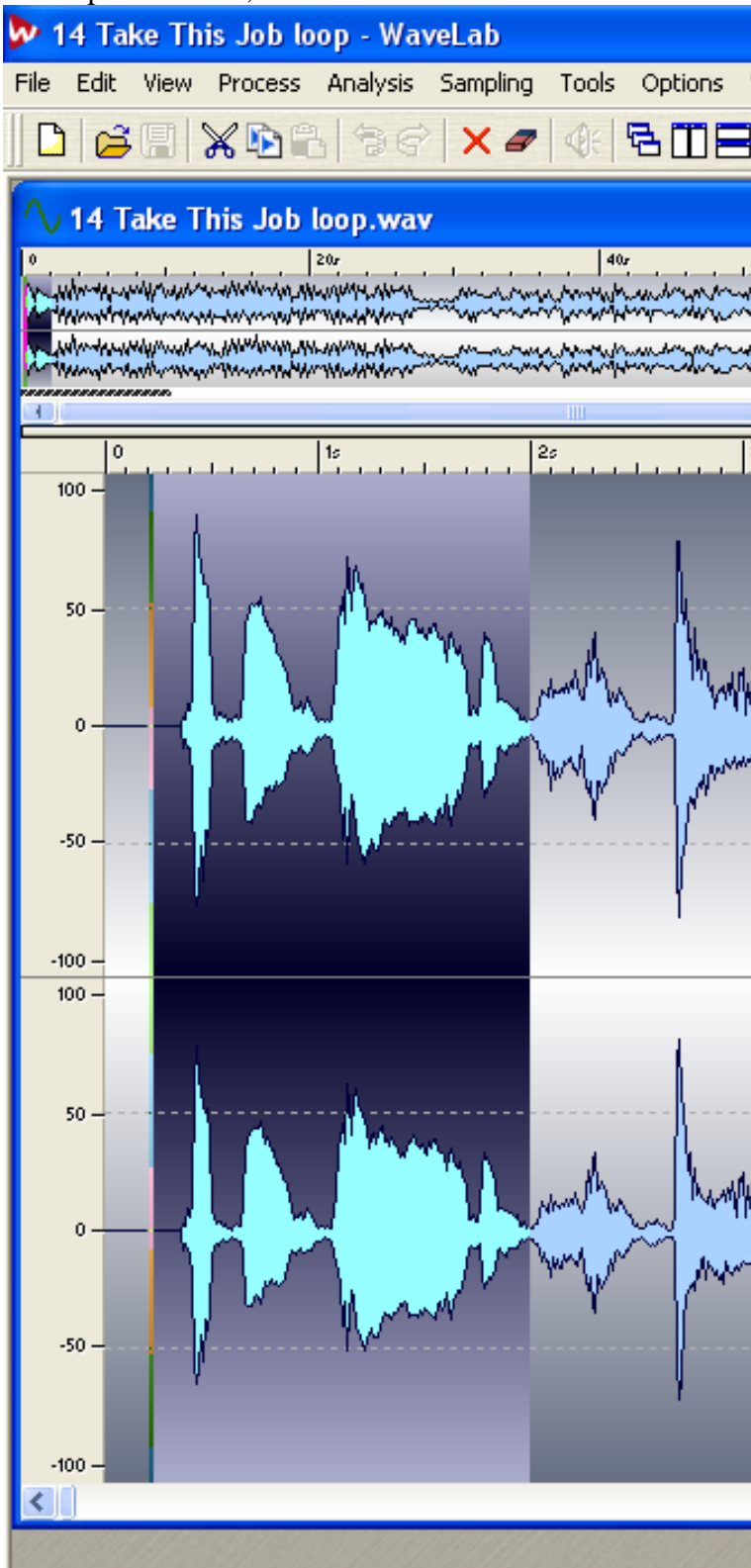
Q: How do I create a loop in Wavelab 6?

A: You can loop an entire file, a selection, or use a set of loop markers.

To loop an entire file, go to the fourth icon on the transport and change it to the option “Loop Entire File.”



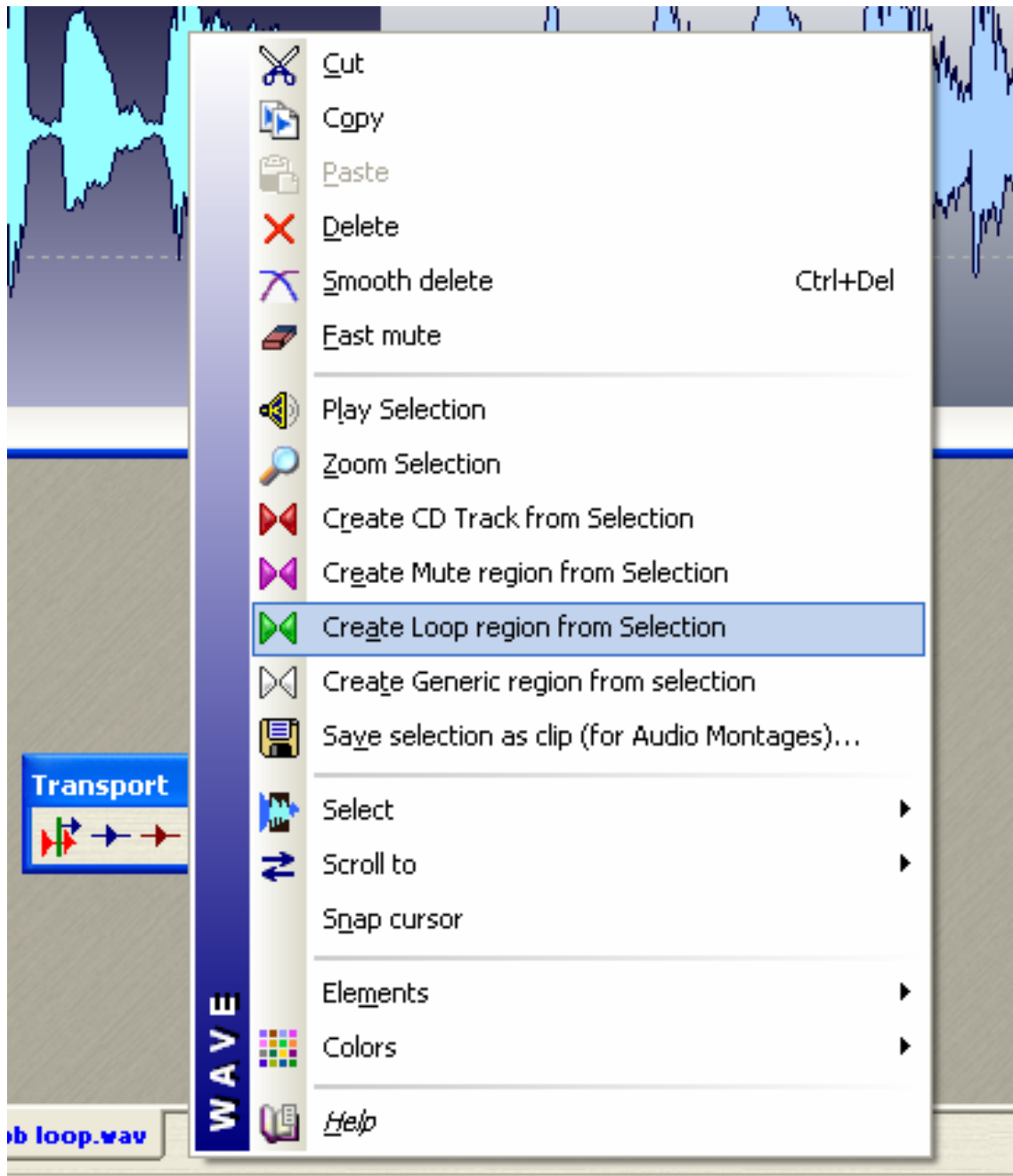
To loop a selection, first create a selection in Wavelab.



Then change the transport to “Loop Selection.”



To create a set of Loop Markers, create a selection. Then right click on the selection and choose Create Loop region from Selection.



Now in the Transport bar, select “Loop as Marked.” You can move the Loop Markers and still have the ability to make other selections in this mode.
