

How do you organize Master Plugins into Groups in Wavelab?

Working with groups

The Master Section plug-ins can be organized into groups. This is done by adding subfolders to the Master Section folder and then dragging Plug-in icons into these folders.

When you then select from the plug-in menus or display lists of plug-ins, the organization you have created will be reflected in the menu/list.

To create a group, click the New Group button, enter a name and press [Return].

The group will initially appear at the end of the list, but when you start using it, the list will be resorted so that the groups are displayed in alphabetical order.

To delete a group, select it and click Delete Group.

If the group contains any plug-ins, they will not be deleted. Instead, they will appear in the Master Section section, outside all other groups.

Moving plug-ins between groups is done by dragging and dropping, just as when dragging files in the Windows Explorer.

If you lose track of your changes and wish to return to the state that the list was in when you first opened the dialog, click Undo Changes.

If you want to restore everything to the default "factory settings", click "Set default".

This setting is stored in "Wavelab/Presets/Plugins/PlugInPrefAE.set" and "Wavelab/System/plugin.set". If you ever encounter problems with "lost" plug-ins, delete these files and the program will re-scan and build a new list of plug-ins the next time you launch it.
