

Wavelab 6: Changing the Volume Scale Properties

When you open an audio file in Wavelab 6, you will notice the Volume Scale on the left. (Fig. 1)

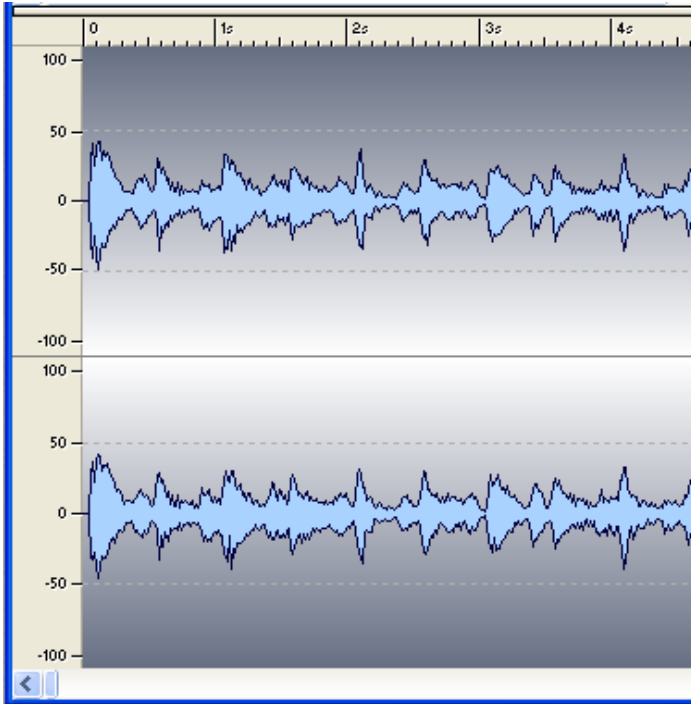

You can customize the volume scale to show percentage, dB or decimal values. To do this, you can right click on the Volume scale. In the example below, the volume scale is changed to dB values.

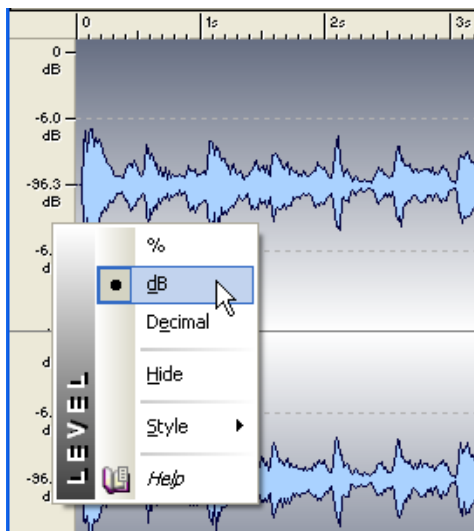

Also, in the Level menu, you can change the style from 3D to Mingled. If the style is Mingled, The Volume Scale will be mixed with the background of the wave, giving it a transparent look. (Fig. 3)

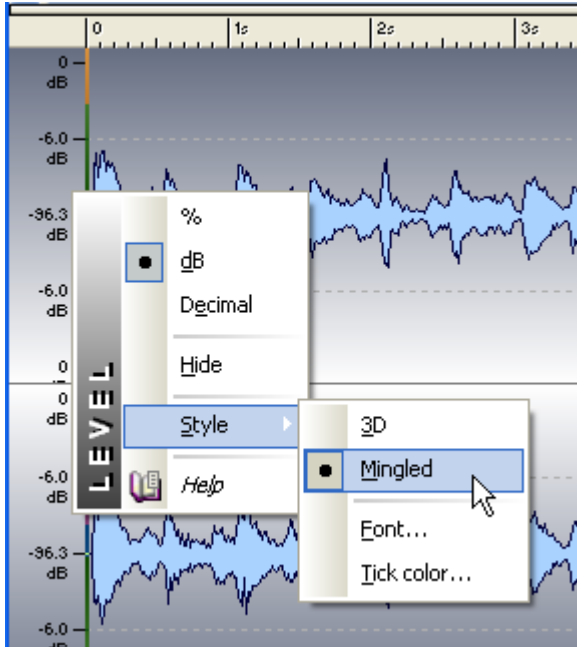
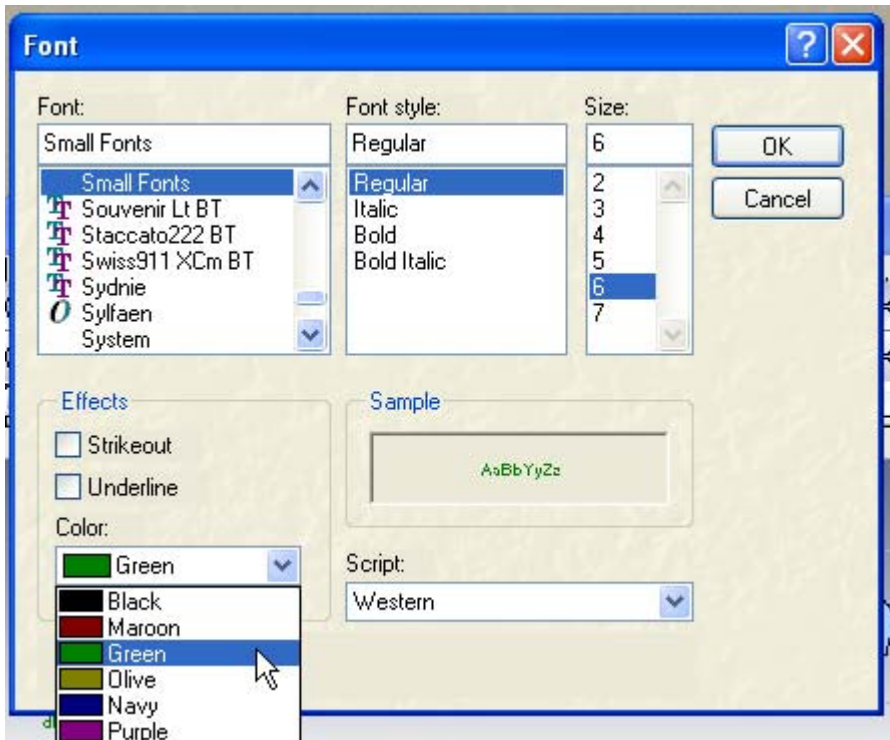
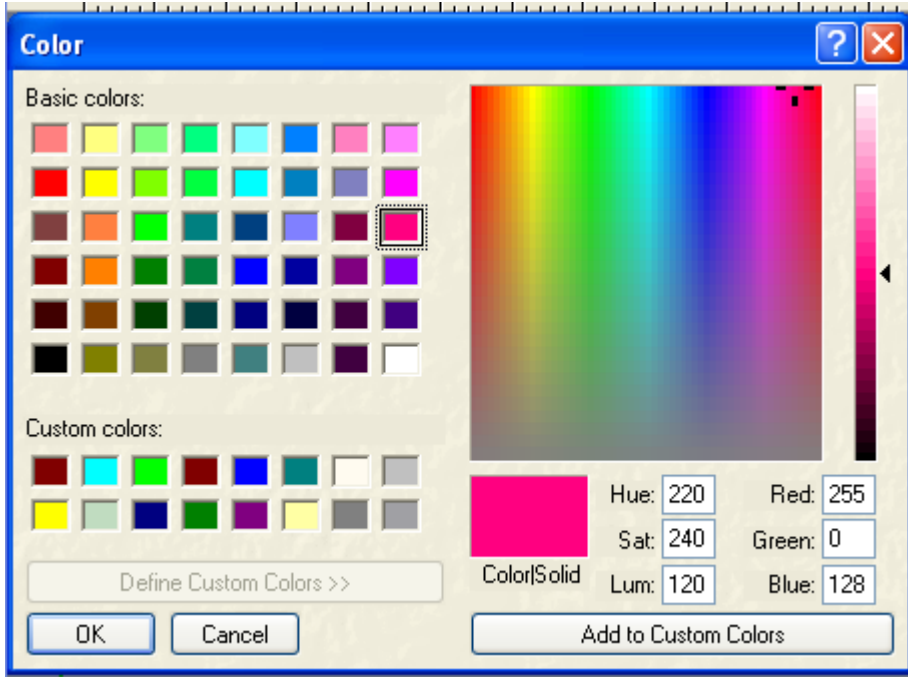
